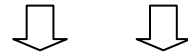

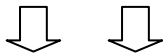


ADVERB VERB


Useful Tip > Vocabulary

 Dragons usually help their friends. They are **courageous** but sometimes they are **introverted**.




GOAT / RAM
